Scavenger Hunt

1. Large groups of people listening/dancing to bands (particularly when the big stages are packed and if you can get up high to see the massive crowds that accumulate)
2. People up and dancing to the band
3. People drinking beer, looking into camera – tight shots
4. People eating food, looking into camera – tight shots – also try to get someone eating Irish Stew in front of the sign that says “Irish Stew”
5. Shots in animal adoption area
6. Kids petting dogs
7. Irish Wolfhounds
8. Irish Setters
9. Any dressed-up dogs you find
10. Any families/groups
11. Different ethnicities/diversity (we want to show the variety that exists in our festival!)
12. Kids doing crafts at Urchin Street – very tight shots focusing on one or two kids
13. Kids listening to entertainment on Urchin Street Stage (preferably a group of kids)
14. People interacting with horses or other animals
15. At least one shot of each chef/mixologist on the chef stage – don’t be afraid to get close
16. Good shots of Irish step dancing
17. Storyteller with kids gathered around
18. Sheepherding demo photos
19. Fencing demos – shots of performers and also people watching
20. For the Fun Run on Saturday morning – people dressed up and lacing up their shoes, people at the start line, anxious to run, anyone decked out in fun gear doing something active. Both tight shots and wide shots that show they are in Fair Park.

NTIF states – “Please note that while we do like it when people get dressed up in elaborate, Renaissance-style costumes, the shots that are ultimately the most useful to the PR team are images of people dressed casually (or even festively with an Irish-themed T-shirt or something).”
