2. Install them in the right location

- Windows > System32 > spool > drivers > color
- On **Mac OSX** **profiles** are located at one of the following two locations: **Mac HD/Library/ColorSync/Profiles** - if located here all **users** can use them, but only admin **users** and authenticated installers can add or remove them.
The other would be in the **User / Library / ColorSync / Profiles**.

Note: Restart the software after install a new profile so it shows up.

3/4. Tell your photo software to manage colors and Select the profile in your software's print dialog




In Photoshop or Elements, this is done with a drop down option in the print dialog. With Lightroom and Aperture, simply choosing a profile name in the Print Module does the job.






Provided you installed the profile correctly, it will be visible inside the printer profile drop down menu of your photo software. The list of profiles will likely be large, as it is displaying profiles of all types (not just inkjet papers) in this list.
Scroll down in the alphabetical listing until you see your profile.
