




- 1. Training to learn how to do after <u>processing</u> my images to enter into contests, from what the judge's comments improved my photography skill.





HOW DO I START MAKING PHOTOS?

- Know your camera (phone, point-and-shoot, SLR, mirrorless, film)
- Understand the exposure triangle but start simple. (PPC offers classes)
- Practice: Take pictures. (PPC activities)
- Enter PPC monthly contests to learn from critiques
- Train your eye in composition and light; study art and fine photography.
- Learn to be an objective "judge." (PPC training)
- Choose an editing tool like Lightroom (PPC offers classes and tips)
- Be curious. Try new techniques, settings, angles, etc.
- Attend PPC meetings
- Explore the PPC web site for ideas, photo examples, past training notes and videos, resources








MAGNETIC NAMETAG (OPTIONAL)




